

Instructions

Customs see to it that your EORI number and other corporate data are entered in the European Commission's EORI database. The data in question are described on the next page of this declaration. Customs administrations of the EU Member States can consult this database to check whether an EORI number exists.

Other Economic Operators (market parties) can also consult this database to find out whether your EORI number exists. Your name and address may also be disclosed, but only if you have given your written consent. You can do this by completing and returning this declaration.

Whether or not you give consent will have no consequences for the way in which your customs formalities are dealt with.

Protection of personal data

Both European and Dutch legislation is of course applicable to the protection of personal data. If you would like more information about the protection of your personal data, go to www.belastingdienst.nl and check the brochure 'Wet Bescherming persoonsgegevens' (Personal Data Protection Act).

The following data is contained in the European Union's EORI database

- 1 EORI number
- 2 full name
- 3 business/residential address: the full address of the town/city in which the person is established/resides, including the identifying code of the country or area (two-letter ISO country code)
- 4 VAT identification number(s), if issued by a Member State
- 5 legal form as stated in the deed of incorporation (if applicable)
- 6 formation date or, in the case of a natural person, date of birth
- 7 type of person in coded form as meant in Section 4(1) of the Code of Law. The codes in question are:
 - natural person
 - legal entity
 - association of persons
- 8 contact data: name, address and telephone and/or fax number and/or email address of the contact person
- 9 for persons not established in the EU Customs Area: identification number(s) issued for customs purposes to the person concerned or issued by the competent authorities of the third country with which an agreement for mutual administrative assistance in customs matters has been concluded. This/these identification number(s) must contain the identifying code of the country or area in question
- 10 principal economic activity, expressed by a four-digit code in accordance with the Statistical Classification of Economic Activities in the European Community (NACE), as listed in the corporate register of the Member State in question (if applicable)
- 11 expiry date of the EORI number (if applicable)
- 12 consent to the publication of personal data listed under numbers 1, 2 and 3 above, if consent has been given
- 13 your AEO status (if applicable).
