Authorisation temporary admission

Information and general conditions

This information is for companies with an authorisation for 'Temporary admission'.

What can you do with this authorisation?

The authorisation gives you permission to use the 'Temporary admission' procedure. This means you may use non-Union goods, within the customs territory of the Union, for which you do not have to pay all or part of the import duties or national taxes. You must, however, export these goods from the customs territory of the Union after use. Commercial policy measures also do not apply to these goods.

General terms and conditions

Certain terms and conditions apply to the authorisation. You will find a description of these below.

Guarantee

You may only use this authorisation, if you have provided a guarantee.

Notification requirement

Customs monitors the use of the goods. Customs can oblige you to report at a certain time or at the beginning or end of a certain activity related to the use. This means that you may have to notify Customs about things such as:

- the arrival of the goods at the location where they will be used
- the start and/or end of use
- any irregularities during use
- the departure of the goods from the location where they have been used

If you want to report something, please use the 'Customs notification (Kennisgeving Douane)' form. You can find the form on douane.nl.

Administrative obligations

It is important that you maintain good administrative records. General rules about the administrative obligations can be found in the 'Customs Manual' on douane.nl (only available in Dutch).

Special rules may apply to the layout of the administration and recording of data. Read the individual conditions mentioned in the authorisation.

Changes

When there are changes in the data that affect this authorisation, please pass them on to Customs.
